“In view of the time limited outstanding decisions and as it is not known how long the current measures to protect Public Health will be in place, the advice from One Voice Wales , NALC and the SLCC is that the Council should consider :

“extending the delegation of Council decisions to the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Clerk during any period of restricted activity declared by the Government in respect of the Covid-19 virus. Such delegation to enable the Council to fulfil its responsibilities to its residents”.

Note that this should be resolved by full council or at least a quorum of full council and then all meetings will be suspended. Some are doing this by email and worrying about it later. If you continue to meet virtually, making decisions, with no public or press present, you would be acting unlawfully. After delegation, the clerk in the meantime would just continue the running of the business of council and would pay any bills or emergency bills due but wouldn't be making any new decisions.
